5. What happens when the monsoon comes late or not at all ? **shortage of crops and food**
6. What happens during the winter months ? **winds change direction, they blow from inner parts of Asia, no rainfall, very dry**
7. What religion do most people in India have ? **Hindu**
8. How many people live in India ? What will happen in the near future ? **1.3 billion, India is already the most populous nation**
9. What are the problems of larger cities ? **overpopulation, pollution, traffic problems**
10. Name a few Indian cities: **Mumbai, Delhi, Kolkata, Hyderabad, Bangalore**
11. Which people are at the top of the caste system and who is in the lowest caste ? **at the top are priests (Brahmins) , at the bottom peasants, servants, farmers**
12. What are untouchables ? **homeless people outside the caste system**

14. Who were the Mughals ? **powerful group of Muslims who ruled India at about 1500**
15. What functions did the British East India Company have ? **controlled trade and governed India**
