- 1. What are cells ? tiny elements of living material
- 2. What does a malignant tumor do? it spreads to healthy cells and destroys them
- 3. What happens when a tumor metastasizes? it spreads to other organs and body parts
- 4. Name a few types of cancer? lung cancer, breast cancer, leukemia, bowel cancer, prostate cancer etc..
- 5. Name a few typical symptoms of cancer? lose weight, blood in urine, lumps in a woman's breast,
- 6. Give examples of how the environment may cause cancer? smoking, alcohol, being in the sun too much
- 7. What are the three main methods of treating cancer? surgery, radiotherapy, chemotherapy
- 8. How has modern medicine changed cancer treatment? chances of survival are much higher, methods have fewer side effects
- 9. What is radiotherapy? X-rays or gamma rays are beamed directly into the tumor
- 10. What does chemotherapy do and what are the negative side effects? chemicals are injected into the body to kill off cancer cells, it may also destroy healthy cells
- 11. What does the immune system produce? antibodies
- 12. What are the most common types of cancer? lung cancer, breast cancer
